

F3 Technical Regulation Bulletin

No: TRBF3-2020-005
Date: January 24, 2020
Subject: Video Cameras

Sporting Regulations section 26.8 is changed as follows:

All Competitors must use the factory supplied data logging system. Logged data may not be downloaded or cleared during Parc Ferme.

A video camera of any manufacture may be used. The camera must be installed and operating during all sessions at an event. The video camera must record in MP4 or MOV format using a Micro-SD or SD card. Other than a date and time stamp, the camera may not log any other data or overwrite it on the video image.

The camera must be mounted to the OEM Ligier bracket on the center top of the main roll hoop. No other location is permitted. Nothing may obstruct the camera picture. Competitors must ensure the functionality of the camera at all times.

Additional video cameras, if used, may not be mounted to the exterior or interior of the driver's helmet.

Competitors are required to submit video cards to the Stewards of the meet within 30 minutes of the end of each session. See Article 48 for detailed procedure. Failure to comply will result in a report to the Stewards and may result in a penalty.

Notes:

- The above rule will be included in the 2020 F3 Sporting Regulations. This TRB is issued in advance of release of the Sporting Regulations as a courtesy to teams.
- Other than formatting, changes to 26.8 from 2019 are as follows:
 - Clarify that cameras must mount to the OEM Ligier bracket on the roll hoop and nowhere else.
 - Add requirement for video file format.
 - Roll over TRBF3-2019-003, which prohibits helmet-mounted cameras.
 - Prohibit downloading or clearing the data logger during Parc Ferme.
