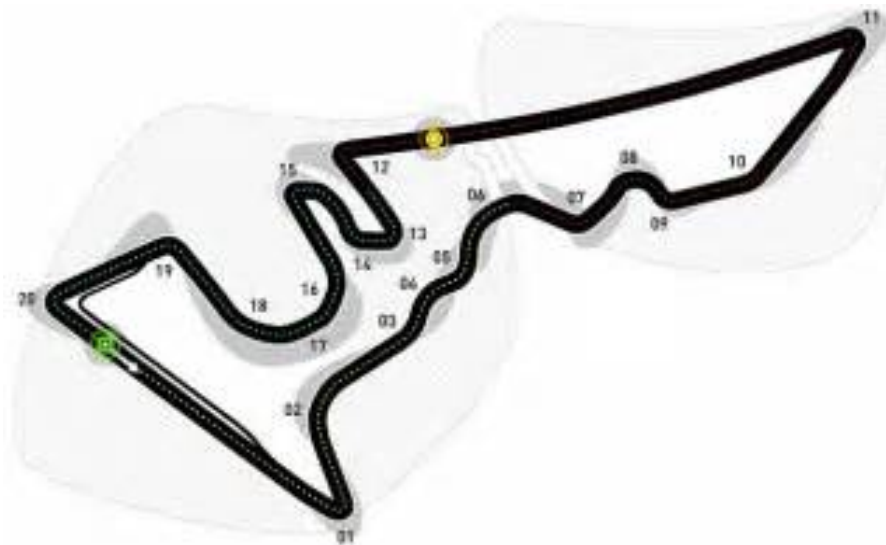

CREW CHIEF BRIEFING NOTES



1.00 SERIES MEETINGS:

All series meetings are mandatory. Content of meetings become part of the regulations for the weekend.

2.00 TECHNICAL INSPECTION:

2.01 Official Scales

Official scales and measuring tools are available during the times posted on the schedule, unless closed for impound. **Do not drive on scales.**

2.02 Driver Gear:

This will be checked at each event. Drivers will also sign to confirm this is the clothing, helmet, HANS, etc. that they are wearing while on track.

2.03 Minimum ride Height:

As described in Rule Clarification (RC) 003, at any time, at static, (i.e. technical inspection), ride height, no sprung part of the car may be lower than 30mm above a flat plane defined by the contact patches of all four tires. This measurement will be checked with tire pressures at 20psi and driver in the car.

3.00 FUEL HANDLING

See F4 Sporting Regulations Article 29.4 for all fuel handling operations

3.02 Parc Ferme:

Begins immediately on presentation of the checkered flag after qualifying. No stopping in pit lane. Top 3 and others instructed by Technical Director proceed to F4 Series trailer. All others to leave car outside their designated garage/tent space until Parc Ferme conditions end.

No cars may return to the paddock before the qualifying session is over without permission from Technical Director.

CREW CHIEF BRIEFING NOTES



4.00 PIT LANE:

- 4.01** No shorts will be allowed on Pit Lane during any official sessions.
- 4.02** Smoking or Vaping is not allowed on Pit Lane at any time.
- 4.03** If a F4 staff member notifies team of a black flag it will be considered the same as displaying such flag.
- 4.04** No team personnel permitted at outer pit wall for starts. 1 team member per car is permitted to set car in start box and then return to pit box.

5.00 RAIN:

- 5.01** When rain tires are used, car must have rain light turned on.
- 5.02** Rain tires are not required to be stamped for practice sessions.

6.00 SPILLS/RECYCLING:

All spills must be cleaned up or track fines may occur. Safety-Kleen waste stations are available throughout the paddock.

7:00 PIT ASSIGNMENTS:

To be assigned at first Crew Chief Meeting.

8:00 RADIO FREQUENCIES:

All radio frequencies with corresponding car numbers must be turned into Technical Director.

9:00 FIRE BOTTLES:

Fire bottle must be operational for all on track sessions. Power switch must be on.

10.00 VIDEO CAMERAS:

- 10.01** All F4US cars must have operable video cameras located in the stock position on the left side of the roll bar.
- 10.02** All cars must submit video cards to tech within 30 minutes of the end of that session. SEE Rules Clarification # 0005 for complete procedure description. **PENALTIES WILL BE ISSUED FOR NON – COMPLIANCE.**
