Technical Rules Bulletin 2017-009 Helmet Height Enforcement

Per 15.2.2 of the FIA Formula 4 Technical regulations, the driver's helmet must be at least 70mm below a line between the main rollover structure and the secondary rollover structure just forward of the steering wheel. The Technical Staff uses a template to check this rule.

Currently, we make this check either at the beginning of the season or before a new driver's first race.

Beginning at the final race this year (October COTA), we will use the template to check selected drivers on the pre-grid before official practice sessions, qualifying, or races. We will select the drivers to be checked based on a visual assessment of a high helmet.

NOTE – Any driver found with a helmet that violates the template will not be permitted to participate in the session.
