Subject: Written Notice of Engine Service or Change

Effective immediately...

The Technical Delegate and the engine provider must be notified in writing in advance of removing an engine for service, repairs, or power confirmation by the provider or of replacement with a different engine. Removal or replacement without notice will be considered service of a Type 1 part by someone other than the manufacturer. Penalties will be separate and in addition to any penalties resulting from Section 28.2.

Notes:

- The above rule will be added to the 2020 Sporting Regulations. However, it is in effect immediately via this Technical Regulation Bulletin.
- These restrictions apply to off-season service or engine changes as well as changes once the 2020 season begins. Any cars arriving at 2020 annual tech with a different engine from the one used in 2019 will be in violation if written notice has not been given by the team.
- See TAMF4-2019-011 (to be released shortly) for specifics of enforcement, including the form to be used for notification. If engine service is already underway or complete prior to release of this TAM, notify the Technical Delegate via email.
