Subject: Championship Track Testing

The following replaces CRBF4-2020-001

Rule 21.3 of only the 2020 F4 U.S. Championship Sporting Regulations will be changed to the following:

Beginning *June 1* of the current season, no Championship driver may test or race a Championship car prior to any Championship Event, on any configuration of any track that will host a Championship Event, during the current season with the exception of an SCCA-sanctioned event held more than 2 weeks prior to a Championship Event.

Competitors participating in the SCCA-sanctioned event may participate in the test day immediately preceding the event, regardless of who sanctions it.

Testing is permissible at such tracks after the close of the Championship Event activity, until the last day of February 2021.

Testing is permissible at any SCCA Pro Racing sanctioned test event, as outlined on the official schedule.

Teams choosing to test on Championship tracks between now and June 1 should inform SCCA Pro Racing of their intent to test so additional teams have the opportunity to participate.
