The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director regarding an incident during F4 Race 2, and having examined video/ evidence, have considered the matter and determine the following:

<b>No/Driver</b>	No. 77 - Jason Alder
<b>Competitor</b>	Velocity Racing Development
<b>Time</b>	15:13
<b>Session</b>	F4 Round 5 – Road America Race 2
<b>Facts</b>	The No. 77 failed to slow for a developing incident near Turn 11, passing a number of cars already slowing for the incident, and then having significant contact with the No. 98 and No. 8 car. All 3 cars involved retired from the race due to damage.
<b>Offence</b>	Breach of Articles 15.1.d and 15.5.1.i of the Sporting Regulations – “ <i>Causing a collision</i> ” and “ <i>Unsafe Act</i> ”, and of the International Sporting Code Appendix L Chapter IV – Code of Driving Conduct on Circuits – Article 2.e – “ <i>Driving in a manner deemed potentially dangerous to other drivers at any time</i> ”
<b>Decision</b>	The Stewards suspend the driver – Jason Alder – for the next race in the series. In addition, the Stewards impose a penalty of 3 penalty points.
<b>Reason</b>	The Stewards consider the actions of the driver to be reckless.

The Competitor is reminded of his right to appeal in accordance with Article 16.2 of the Sporting Regulations except where the penalties are not susceptible to appeal (Article 16.2.5 of the Sporting Regulations).
