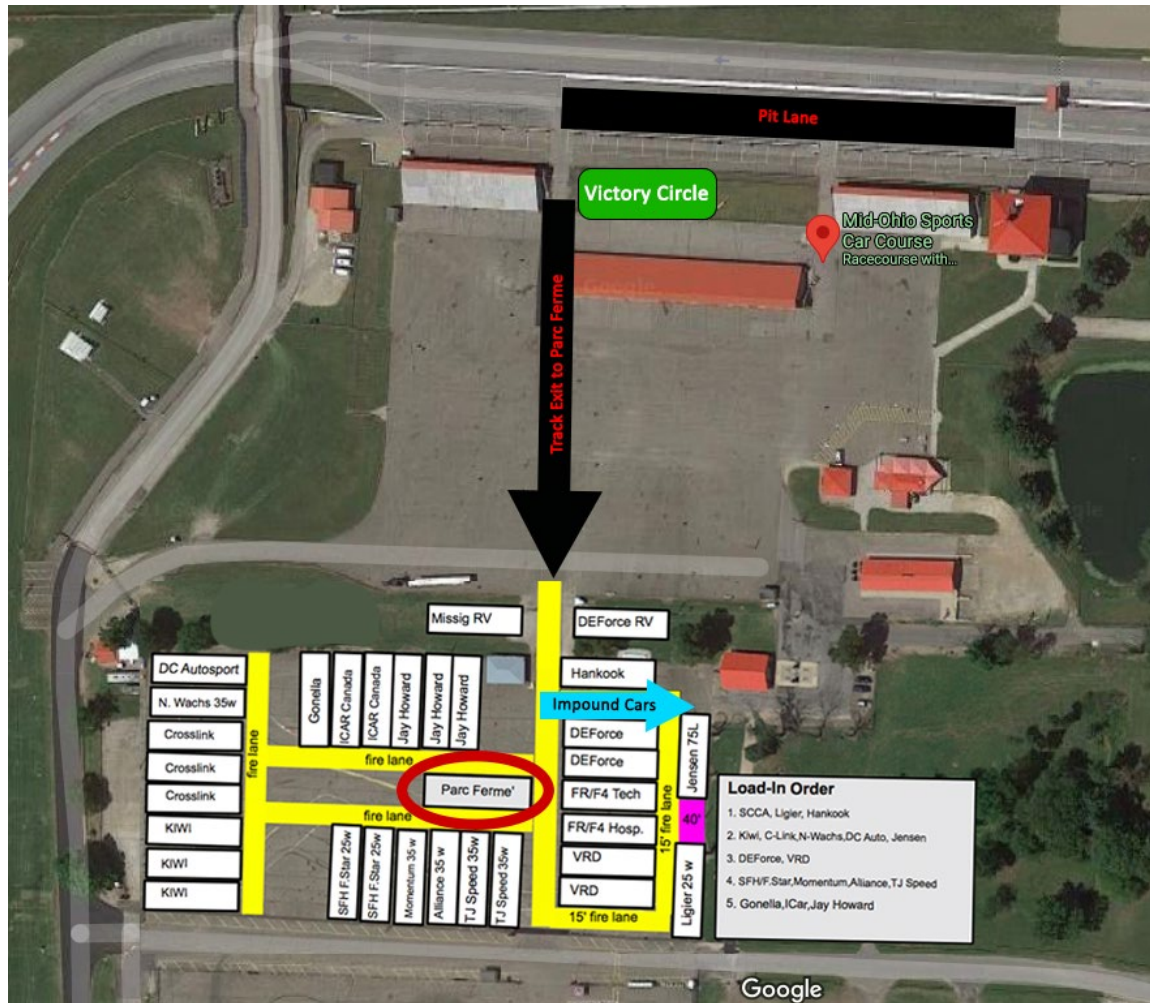

Post-Session Traffic Flow



- At the conclusion of any session, all cars will enter pitlane.
- After Qualifying
 - Impound Cars to tech following the blue arrow
 - All other cars to Parc Fermé area and observe Parc Fermé procedures
- After Races
 - The winning car will go straight to the Mid-Ohio victory circle stage located directly behind pitlane
 - P2 and P3 finishers in each class and other racers pertinent to the race narrative (Race Control will announce) will stop on pit lane. Drivers will leave their helmets and equipment with the car and immediately go to the stage. A member from the driver's team will drive the car and equipment back tech.
 - The balance of the field will return to Parc Fermé area and observe Parc Fermé procedures.

Post-Race Procedures

Masks will not be required for victory circle if you are vaccinated. Series-branded masks will be available for the drivers who choose to wear one on the podium or for those who are unvaccinated

Interview

- Winning driver will do his/her celebration, then stand by the car to wait for interview (take off equipment and leave in car) from GreenLight.TV.
- Stream crew will interview the winning driver for the Live Stream by his/her respective car in the winner's circle.
- After the winning driver completes his/her interview, proceed to the podium and maintain 6-foot distancing. Masks WILL NOT be required on the podium, SCCA Pro Racing will provide one if you prefer to wear a mask.
- Live Stream interviews will be used for post-race notes and quotes, eliminating multiple contacts with the same driver.
- There will NOT be post-race media conferences. Media will reach out to drivers as needed.
- Master Class winners will be included in Victory Lane activities.

Podium

- “No contact” trophy presentations. We will continue the “No Contact” trophy presentations with trophies placed on the podium steps. There MIGHT be a trophy presenter for one race. Presenter will take precautions by wearing a mask if not vaccinated and still using sanitizer between driver hand offs. Presenters will NOT do handshakes.
- Drivers are to remain separated as the podium steps will remain further apart.
- John Fippin will conduct a SHORT interview with each driver on the podium.
- Donna Bastrzycki will present a hat for you to wear onto the podium.
- We WILL do the hat dance for this race. A line of hats will be on your podium step. All used hats will be placed in the individual baskets located behind the podium steps. You can collect your basket of hats at the end of the podium celebrations
- Photos will be taken of the drivers on the podium with masks, provided hat, and trophy.
- Sparkling grape juice (already uncorked) will be provided for you to you. We will be reintroducing podium celebrations into our format this year. Please remember that this is white grape juice. It is sticky. You have three races in the summertime heat. We recommend NOT spraying each other until at least the last round. When you're spraying off stage DO NOT spray the photographers OR the camera crew, their equipment is expensive.
- The team of winning driver will need to take the car directly back to tech after final photo.
- Photographers must be 6 ft from podium
- Family and team members need to be 6 ft behind photographers and social distance amongst each other.
- MASKS MUST BE WORN AT THE PODIUM by those who are unvaccinated.
- REMEMBER: we only have 10 minutes to get this done, and only 5-7 minutes to get interviews in before the next group takes the track, so we need to be just as speedy off track as we are on the track.
