A minimum of three starters in a class are required to claim Challenge awards. A minimum of five starters in a class are required to claim Championship awards. All awards will be issued in the form of a certificate that must be redeemed through the Hawk Performance website. Certificates may be combined. All certificates will expire on 12/31/17. All Hawk contingency award claims must be accompanied by the official claim form (signed by a tech official), which is available at scca.com, and a copy of the official race results. All claims must be submitted no later than 30 days after each eligible event. See "Payout Schedule" below for award amounts.
