



## 2020 SCCA Runoffs Qualification Criteria

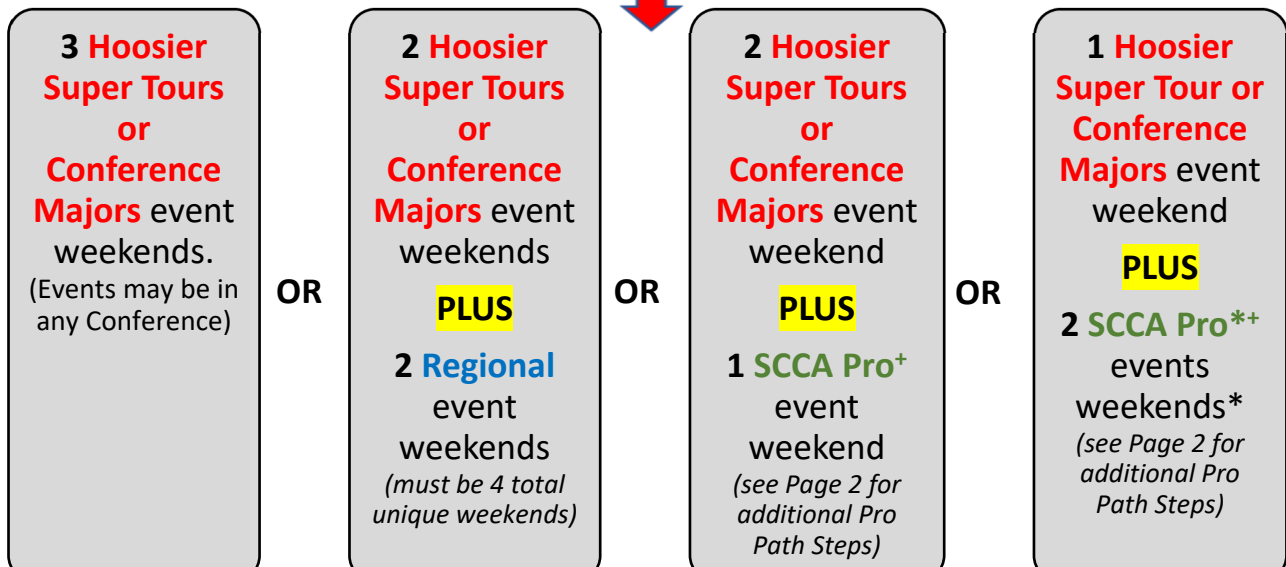
>>New for 2020 – Race starts were replaced with race finishes and you must satisfy a point standings requirement.<<

**DEFENDING NATIONAL CHAMPION** – The current defending National Champion may enter the Runoffs in the class(es) being defended, without meeting any of the below criteria. This provision may not be invoked two consecutive years in the same class, even if he/she repeats as a National Champion.

### U.S. Majors Tour Path (Includes 2+2 and Pro Path)

You must complete each step of the path: Participate, Finish, Point Standings

#### PARTICIPATE (complete one of the 4 grey boxes in full)

#### FINISH

#### Finish 3 Hoosier Super Tour or Conference Majors individual races.

(\*If a driver completes 1 Majors weekend + 2 SCCA Pro event weekends (box 4 above), he/she must finish 2 Hoosier Super Tour or Conference Majors races.)

A FINISH is defined as completing at least half of the laps of the overall race winner.

#### POINT STANDINGS

#### Finish in the TOP 50% of your class point standings of a Majors Conference or the Hoosier Super Tour.

(If your class has less than 20 participants, you must finish in the Top 10 of your class.)

## Divisional Path

*You must complete each step of the path: Participate and Point Standings*

### PARTICIPATE

#### Participate in 4 Runoffs qualifying event weekends

*Must be in the same class, in a single division. Divisions may count U.S. Majors Tour events occurring in their Division. Check your local division championship program for details.*

### POINT STANDINGS

**Finish in the TOP 3 in class (Top 5 for SM/SRF3) of your Divisional Point Standings.** *\*Top 50% for Great Lakes and Central Division for 2020, space permitting.*

#### FINE PRINT:

- *SCCA Regional Event Weekends:* Participation in 1 U.S. Majors Tour event weekend may be replaced or substituted with participation in 2 Regional event weekends, but you must still complete the Majors Path race finish and Majors Path point standings portion of the qualification criteria. If a Region holds a Majors event with a Regional-sanctioned run group and a driver participates in both the Majors and Regional run group in the same Runoffs-eligible class, only Majors credit will be earned toward qualification. Regional events must occur between January 1, 2020 and a date not less than 2 weeks prior to the start of the Runoffs (September 22, 2020) and may be in any division. Excludes Enduros.
- *\*SCCA Pro Racing provision:* Drivers in specific classes, as defined in GCR 3.7.4.A.1.a, may replace (substitute) participation in up to two (2) Majors event weekends with an SCCA Pro Racing weekend(s). Drivers who substitute one (1) Majors weekend (**2 Majors + 1 SCCA Pro**) must have three (3) Majors/Super Tour race finishes. Drivers who substitute two (2) Majors weekends with two (2) SCCA Pro Racing weekends (**1 Majors + 2 SCCA Pro**) must have two (2) Majors/Super Tour race finishes. Regardless of the above, drivers must also satisfy the U.S. Majors Tour Path points standings requirement. Drivers must request this replacement via email at [runoffs@scca.com](mailto:runoffs@scca.com) by September 16, 2020 and pay the entry fee(s) to the Majors event(s) of their choice, to be collected by the SCCA National Office and distributed to the SCCA Regions.
  - o GT1 – TA
  - o GT2 – TA2 or SGT
  - o T1 – SGT or GT
  - o FA – F3, Atlantic (FRP), FB (FRP)
  - o FX – F4
  - o FC – F2000 (FRP)
  - o FF – F1600 (FRP)
- The criteria in this document are minimum requirements.
- “Participate” is defined as turning a wheel on track in an official session (practice, qualifying, warm-up, race) and appearing in the Official Race Results.
