Program Duration:	* All 2020 U.S. Major Tour events. And all Hoosier Super Tour Events.
Registration:	* Competitors must register each year to be eligible for awards. * Competitors must be registered in the program prior to competing. No awards will be paid if you do not follow all of the contingency procedures. * Register for this program online at: http://www.hoosiertire.com/contingency_program/
Class Eligibility List:	* EP, FP, HP, GT1, GT2, GT3, GTL, GTX, T1, T2, T3, T4, B-SPEC, STU, STL, AS, SM F5, FA, FC, FE2 , FF, FV, P1, P2, PX, FX
Requirements:	* Competitor must race with Hoosier Racing Tires on all four wheel positions and wear a Hoosier patch on their driving uniform. * Decals Required: YES * # of Decals: Three (3) on all classes other than FE2 (see note below) Location: One (1) 11" decal on <u>each side</u> and one (1) 11" decal on the front. No exceptions will be made for this rule. No competing tire decals, and decals must be contrasting colors from the race car. * # of Decals in the FE2 class: Five (5) Location on FE2: One (1) 8" decal on the nose of the front shock cover of the car. Two (2) 11" decal on the outside vertical plane of each front wing plate. Two (2) 11" decal on the vertical plane of each of the lower floor panels just in front of rear wheels. It is the competitor's responsibility to register properly and neatly apply decals. Decals used must be the officially supplied Hoosier Decals. * Availability: Decals and Patch, if needed, will be mailed if requested at registration. Award Information:	* Product awards are presented to all eligible 1st and 2nd place finishers meeting the starting SCCA US Major Tour requirements outlined above: DNS are not counted in the class count. * Contingency forms must be completely filled out and include all supplemental information; copy of official results, proof of purchase & photos. Original proof of purchase must be made available to Hoosier if requested. Tires must be purchased from an authorized Hoosier Racing Tire Distributor or a Track Side Support Dealer. Tires must be purchased at MSRP to be eligible for the contingency program. * A minimum of three (3) competitors are required in a class to claim 1st place awards, and five (5) cars are required to claim 2nd place awards. * Spec Miata (SM) competitors will also be awarded for 3rd-8th place finishes at Hoosier Super Tour events. Additionally, all eligible SM Division and Conference Champions will receive four (4) free tires. Spec Miata (SM) Hoosier Super Tour Points winners will receive eight (8) tires, four (4) tires for 2nd, and two (2) tires for 3rd. * Competitors may only submit claims for the same size tire for which they competed and which they can provide proof of purchase. * Tires will be awarded for a maximum of one official points paying race per day, and a maximum of two official points paying races per weekend event. * All awards must be claimed within 30 days of each eligible event. * See "Payout Schedule" below for award amounts.
