Award Information:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cash awards are presented to the 1st – 6th place drivers per race in 2020 SCCA Tire Rack ProSolo National Series competition only. The Mazda competitor must finish ahead of four other starters in class to receive a 100% payout; awards are reduced by 15% for finishing ahead of three competitors; 25% for finishing ahead of two competitors; and 50% if ahead of one other competitor. No award available for last in class. To claim points championship prizes, competitor must compete in a minimum of one event. The event must have at least five starters in class. If the event had contingency reduced due to not meeting the requirement, the points championship award will be reduced by the same percentage. For those racers who only compete at the ProSolo Finale (for the ProSolo season), award payout would be \$600 for 1st, \$400 for 2nd and \$200 for 3rd place.
