Registration:	* Competitors must register each year to be eligible for awards. * Competitors must be registered in the program prior to competing. No awards will be paid if you do not follow all of the contingency procedures. * Register for this program online at: http://www.hoosiertire.com/contingency_program/
Class Eligibility	* Any open competition class and the following spec classes: FE2, SRF3, SM, and FV.
Requirements:	* Competitor must race with Hoosier Racing Tires on all four wheel positions and wear a Hoosier patch on their driving uniform. * Decals Required: YES, Three (3) on all classes other than FE2 (see note below) Location: One (1) 11" decal on <u>each side</u> and one (1) 11" decal on the front. No exceptions will be made for this rule. No competing tire decals, and decals must be contrasting colors from the race car. * # of Decals in the FE2 class: Five (5) Location on FE2: One (1) 8" decal on the nose of the front shock cover of the car. Two (2) 11" decal on the outside vertical plane of each front wing plate. Two (2) 11" decal on the vertical plane of each of the lower floor panels just in front of rear wheels. It is the competitor's responsibility to register properly and neatly apply decals. Decals used must be the officially supplied Hoosier Decals. * Availability: Decals and Patch, if needed, will be mailed if requested at registration. Award Information:	* Product awards are presented to all eligible 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishers meeting the starting SCCA National Championship Runoffs® requirements outlined above: DNS are not counted in the class count. * Contingency forms must be completely filled out and include all supplemental information; copy of official results, car / decal photos. * A copy of a paid invoice is required and must accompany all redemption forms submitted. The maximum number of contingency tires that can be claimed is equivalent to the quantity of tires listed on a paid invoice, e.g. buy a set of four (4) Hoosier Tires and claim a maximum of four (4) contingency tires for that invoice. The invoice must be dated within 90 days prior of the event. Contingency awarded tires or random draw tires (i.e. no charge tires) will not be eligible for contingency. * A minimum of three (3) competitors are required in a class to claim 1st place awards, and five (5) cars are required to claim 2nd place awards. * Spec Miata (SM). See Spec Miata rules and guidelines. * Competitors may only submit claims for the same size tire for which they competed and which they can provide proof of purchase. * Any tires received through this program are for the recipients use only and are not to be sold. The Hoosier Racing Tire Contingency Program makes no provisions for freight, mounting and balancing. * All awards must be claimed within 30 days of each eligible event. * See "Payout Schedule" below for award amounts. * This is a bronze level contingency program administered and paid entirely by Hoosier Racing Tire.
