- Site access does not begin until **8:00 am on Friday, September 4**. If you arrive before the site opens, DO NOT wait on the Airpark roads as you will be asked to move.
- [There is an Early Arrival area this year.](#) As always, the area is first-come, first-served, but please be considerate of your fellow competitors and park in a way to maximize opportunity. If it is full, you will have to find another area, outside of the Airpark, in which to stage.
 - The Early Arrival area is off of NW 38th & Air Park Rd. To access, please turn onto Air Park Rd and then left onto NW 36th St to then circle into the parking lot. Please DO NOT BLOCK the roll up door on the building.
 - We have been given access to the boxed area and no more. Do not park outside of that area – violators will be towed. Do not block any streets or intersections.
 - And most importantly, be respectful of the businesses around you (and in the Airpark). They are still working while we are hanging out in our concrete beach.
- Over the course of the ProSolo Finale and Solo Nationals, paddock space will be shared with an active Lincoln Airport maintenance facility taxiway. This taxiway runs directly from the Goodyear hangar through the paddock to the runway. The taxiway is marked off with barriers. This taxiway MUST remain open and unblocked 24/7. When you cross the taxiway, either by foot or vehicle, DO NOT STOP or park in the active taxiway or the vehicle will be towed immediately.
