

Registration, Garage and Paddock Information

1. Registration

The 2018 Runoffs will again use MotorsportReg.com for event registration. Registration will open online **August 8 at 10 am CDT** (8 am PDT.) Drivers need NOT have fulfilled Runoffs eligibility requirements to register at that time. Please verify that all your profile account and vehicle information is correct in your MotorsportReg.com prior to registering. Check that your SCCA Member number and Region of Record matches what's listed on your membership card and that your membership and license is valid.

Test Days will be held on October 13-15. Qualifying will be on October 16-18, followed by three days of racing, October 19-21. The link to register can be found on the Runoffs event page, www.scca.com/runoffs.

3. Garages

We will utilize the two garage buildings (H Garage and I Garage), located trackside. Tech will occupy Garages 1-10, leaving 11-40, 41/42 and 43/44 available for rent. The garage buildings are open inside, with no barrier walls between stalls. There is 1 double-wide door per 2 stalls. Each stall (#11-40) is

- approximately 12' wide by 34' deep and includes electrical outlets. Garage stalls 41/42 and 43/44 measure approximately 24'x30'. Each garage stall reservation will include appropriate trailer/rig parking.
- 4. Garage assignments will be handled using a lottery system, as was done in 2016. Drivers interested in reserving a garage for the 2018 Runoffs will be invited to purchase a garage lottery event entry. Garage Lottery Event Entries can be purchased beginning **August 1**. Each garage lottery event entry will cost the equivalent of a 2018 SCCA Runoffs event entry (\$1050). Upon check-out, your credit/debit card will be charged for each garage lottery event entry in your cart (NOTE: This does not register you for the event, it only purchases the lottery entry.) Everyone that purchases a garage lottery event entry will receive a credit of \$1050 on their MotorsportReg.com account to be applied to their 2018 Runoffs entry. You will be entered into the lottery one time for each paid event entry. The garage lottery will close on **August 15**.

Names will be drawn at random for each available garage until the 30 spaces are filled. The remaining names will be drawn randomly to create the wait-list order. Those receiving a garage will be notified by **August 22.** The garage reservation(s) will be added to your Runoffs event registration on MotorsportReg.com and your credit card on file will be charged immediately.

The garage lottery event entry (value \$1050) is not subject to the cancellation and refund policy stated in the 2018 Runoffs supplemental regulations. The lottery event entry may be cancelled without penalty prior to the garage lottery drawing. After the drawing has occurred, you may cancel the event entry if the credit has not been redeemed, however a 50% cancellation fee will apply (\$525.) Once a garage has been purchased, they are non-transferrable. If you do not meet the eligibility requirements and do not qualify for the 2018 Runoffs, your event entry and garage fee will be refunded in full.

If you need to cancel your garage for any reason (other than ineligibility), please do so in writing to runoffs@scca.com. A cancellation fee may apply, please see the 2018 SCCA Runoffs Supplemental Regulations. Garages that are cancelled will be returned to SCCA and offered to the next person on the wait-list. Any garages that are not assigned/rented once the wait-list has been cleared will be included as available spots in the parking reservation system.

5. Paddock Parking Reservations

Because flat, paved space is limited, there will be multi-car minimums applied to paddock space according to size in the Main Paddock. This is similar to the paddock process at the 2017 Runoffs. Lot 2 and the Terrace paddock areas will not be subject to the car minimums, although only one space may be reserved per entry.

MAIN PADDOCK

- One car: 35', 40, 45', 50, 55'; Typically 25' wide.
- Two-car minimum: 60', 70'; Typically 25' wide
- Three-car minimum: 75', 80'; 25' and 30' wide

Please note that single-car space paddock reservations <u>WILL NOT</u> begin on **August 8.** We <u>WILL</u> ask where you intend to paddock during Registration (single-car space, multi-car/team/prep shop space, manufacturer space, garage, etc.)

Prep shops and multi-car groups can submit paddock requests (for spaces 60' and longer) between **August 1 – August 22** at http://www.msreg.com/TeamPaddock Prep shops and multi-car groups will be asked to list all drivers with class that will paddock in their assigned space. Drivers that intend to paddock with a prep shop, multi-car space or manufacturer will be asked to name the prep shop/team/manufacturer during their registration. Drivers must be registered for the event and note the prep shop/team/manufacturer before a paddock space will be assigned. Space assignments for prep shops/multi-car teams/manufacturers will begin **August 27**.

If you are interested in a single-car space (35-55 in length) outside of the designated manufacturer areas, online parking reservations will open on **September 5 (12:00 pm CDT)** through MotorsportReg.com. For single-car paddock spaces, 35 and 40 feet in length, located in the Main Paddock you will be permitted to keep your tow vehicle in your paddock if everything fits within the assigned space. All other **paved, single car spaces** in the Main Paddock will require that your tow vehicle is unhooked and parked in a designated lot. This will allow us to fit more racecars on pavement.

Given the topography of the roads and paddock areas, special consideration will be given to classes with low-clearance cars. A limited number of spaces in the Main Paddock will be held for this purpose for one (1) week, **September 5-12.**
